## Attorney Hardship Policy

When the Fourth Judicial Circuit Juvenile Justice Council offers trainings that allow for continuing education credits from the Minimum Continuing Legal Education Board of the Supreme Court of Illinois (MCLE), the Fourth Judicial Circuit Juvenile Justice Council shall make available a reduced fee of conference fees for attorneys who wish to attend, but for whom the cost of such courses would be a financial hardship. The fee shall be no less than half of the full conference fee and documentation of financial hardship must be submitted to the Fourth Judicial Circuit Juvenile Justice Council 21 days prior to the conference or training utilizing the attached application. In order to receive the reduced rate, the applicant must work for a nonprofit, as recognized by the IRS as a 501 (c)(3), and / or have no other income source of legal practice.

## Illinois Supreme Court Rule 795(f) Financial Hardship Policy

The provider shall have available a financial hardship policy for attorneys who wish to attend its courses, but for whom the cost of such courses would be a financial hardship. Such policy may be in the form of scholarships, waivers of course fees, reduced course fees, or discounts. Upon request by the Board, the provider must produce the detailed financial hardship policy. The Board may require, on good cause shown, a provider to set aside without cost, or at reduced cost, a reasonable number of places in the course for those attorneys determined by the Board to have good cause to attend the course for reduced or no cost.
